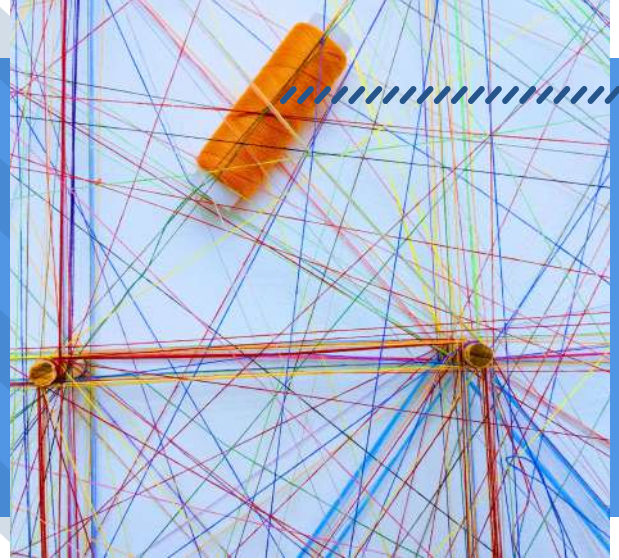
PhiLab - SSHRC Project


